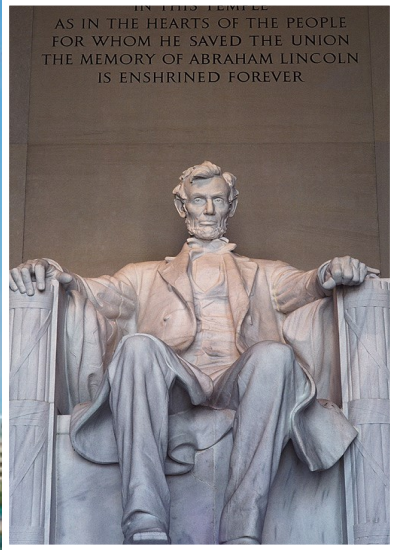

Waiver, Release and Assumption of Risk-As a condition of participating in the student travel program ("Program") described in the Program Terms to which this Waiver, Release and Assumption of Risk is attached, the undersigned Student and, if applicable, the undersigned parent or guardian of the Student agree with Unisphere Travel Ltd., Inc. t/a Colpitts World Travel as follows: As used below, the term "Undersigned" refers to the Student and, if this Agreement is required to be signed by the parent or guardian, to such parent or guardian. As used below, the term "CWT" refers to Unisphere Travel Ltd., Inc. t/a Colpitts World Travel and any companies that control, are controlled by or are under common control with Unisphere Travel Ltd., Inc.

Assumption of Risk. The Undersigned understand(s) that there are certain risks inherent in participating in the program, including, but not limited to, risks related to travel and personal safety, risks of minor, serious or mortal personal injury and risks of property damage. The Undersigned agree(s) that the Student assumes all risks inherent in, arising from or related to the Student's participation in the Program and that CWT shall not be responsible for any such risks.

Waiver of CWT Responsibility. The Undersigned understand(s) and agree(s) that CWT and its directors, officers, attorneys, agents, employees, servants and/or representatives are not responsible or liable for any of the following in connection with the Program: (a) any injury, damage, accident, delay, loss, cost or expense which may result from or be caused by the negligence or default of any company or person engaged in providing or performing services in connection with the Program; (b) any loss, destruction or theft of or damage to the Student's personal property; (c) any injury, damage, accident, delay, loss, cost or expense which may result from or be caused by acts of God, acts of third parties, failure to act by third parties, the regulations or laws of any government, war, civil commotion, hostilities, natural disasters, weather, illness, strikes or other similar causes beyond CWT's control; (d) any injury, damage, accident, delay, loss, cost or expense which may result from or be caused by the Student becoming separated from the other participants in the Program, failing to meet a departing means of transportation or becoming sick or injured; (e) any delay in or disruption of travel arrangements and any consequential damages related thereto; (f) any arrangements for or injury, damage, loss, cost or expense of hospitalization and medical treatment of and medication for the Student; and (g) any legal problems that the Student may have or incur, including, without limitation, problems with foreign nationals and foreign governments, and any injury, damage, loss, cost or expense arising out of or related to such legal problems.

Release. Knowing the dangers, hazards, and risks of such activities, the Undersigned, on behalf of the Undersigned, the Student's heirs, personal representative(s), assigns and anyone else claiming by, through or under the Student, hereby waive(s), release(s), remise(s) and forever discharge(s) CWT, its directors, officers, agents, attorneys, employees, servants and representatives, and their respective successors and assigns (collectively, the "Releasees"), of, from, with respect to and against any and all liability for loss, harm, injury, damage, claims, demands, actions, causes of action, costs (including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees) and expenses of any nature whatsoever both in law and in equity (collectively, "Claims"), which the Undersigned may have or which may hereafter accrue to the Undersigned, arising out of, related to or resulting from purchase of and/or the Student's participation in the Program, including, but not limited to, Claims related to personal injury, death or damage to property, whether caused by the negligence, omission or carelessness of any of the Releasees, or otherwise.

Covenant Not to Sue. The Undersigned, on behalf of the Undersigned, the Student's heirs, personal representatives, assigns and anyone else claiming by, through or under the Student, agrees that he and/or they shall not file any claim, complaint, charge or lawsuit against CWT and/or its directors, officers, attorneys, agents, employees, servants and/or representatives for any matter, claim or incident known or unknown which occurs or arises out of or in any way in connection with, results from or is related to the Student's participation in the Program including, but not limited to, Claims (as defined in the preceding paragraph) related to personal injury, death or damage to property, whether caused by negligence, omission or carelessness of any of the Releasees (as defined in the preceding paragraph), or otherwise.

It is the express intent of the Undersigned that this Agreement shall bind the Undersigned and the Student's family, estate, heirs, administrators, personal representatives and assigns, and the Undersigned agree(s) to indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Releasees from and against any Claim by any such person arising out of or related to the Student's participation in the Program.

Governing Law; Forum; Severability. The Undersigned agree(s) that this Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, without giving effect to the conflict of laws provisions thereof. The terms and provisions of this Agreement shall be severable, such that if a court of competent jurisdiction holds any term to be illegal, unenforceable, or in conflict with any law governing this Agreement the validity of the remaining portions shall not be affected thereby, and each and every term and condition of this Agreement shall be valid and enforced to the fullest extent and in the broadest application permitted by law.

Full Understanding. In executing this Waiver of Liability and Release Agreement, the Undersigned acknowledge(s) and represent(s) that the Undersigned fully understand(s) the content and impact of the provisions hereof and that the execution hereof is the Undersigned's free act and deed.

CANCELLATION FEES PER PERSON: There is a \$200.00 cancellation fee for all cancellations. Cancellations received 60 prior to the departure date are subject to an additional \$50.00 fee per person. Cancellations received within 45 days of the departure date are NON-REFUNDABLE. No shows are NON- REFUNDABLE.
